4. Attach a document from your accountant confirming that the above mentioned company is legally registered and financially sound.
5. Attach a copy of your I.D.

Ensure that your entry is complete. Incomplete or late entries will be disqualified.

Competition Rules

- The competition closes on 31 May 2007. No late entries will be considered.
- The judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The competition is only open to members of the SA Council for Businesswomen or through CHAMSA with SA Council for Businesswomen. New members are welcome to join by contacting their nearest branch.
- The winner must be available for any media events organised by the SA Council for Businesswomen.
- For each of the categories, nominees need to be South African citizens or residents who conduct business in a sole owner capacity or in a partnership in the region of the SA Council for Businesswomen branch where they have been nominated.
